

IDJC Student Support Award, Washington, DC

The Syracuse University Institute for Democracy, Journalism, & Citizenship grants a limited number of small awards each year to support Maxwell School students engaged with the educational or research and mission of the IDJC and taking semester-long courses in Washington D.C. The funding aims to support students who hold unpaid but desirable internship positions or otherwise demonstrate financial need to facilitate their semester in Washington.

Students are eligible to apply for IDJC funding if they are: enrolled in one or more courses offered by IDJC faculty during their semester in D.C., if they hold one of the IDJC internships, or if they are doing research directly related to the IDJC mission. Students who receive funding will be expected to attend or participate in at least two IDJC events, field-trips, or lectures during their semester in Washington. Award amounts will typically range from \$1,200 to \$5,000 per semester. All applications are subject to preliminary review by the Office of Financial Aid & Scholarship Programs.
